This fund provides graduate assistantships to students in the MHP program within the CED. Assistantships are awarded to incoming students based on merit and prior academic performance.


GEORGIA COMMITMENT SCHOLARSHIP (GCS) PROGRAM



JACK CROWLEY

Jack Crowley has led a long, successful and varied career in government, the military, the private sector and in academia. He has been a planning director in small cities and large metropolitan regions. He was chief planner for a state park system and a senior corporate real estate development executive whose team built more than \$2 billion in downtown mixeduse projects in several major US cities. After directing the Oklahoma Department of Transportation he served for 10 years as Dean of the College of Environment and Design at the University of Georgia. In 2006 Jack founded the master's degree program in Urban Planning and Design at UGA, advised the mayor of Tulsa on downtown development for 18 months and returned to Athens to direct the MUPD until it was accredited in 2017. Dr. Crowley retired in 2020 with plans to still teach and advise on planning and development.
