## Introduction


What is a historic architecture survey?



A historic architecture survey is a survey of buildings of historical, architectural, and cultural significance. The primary goal of a historic architecture survey is to collect a minimum level of information needed by a city-, county-, region or state for preservation activities. Completed surveys can be used to promote research of the city's history and architecture, aid preservation and land-use planning efforts, identify individual buildings, or collections of buildings as districts, for listing in the National Register of Historic Places and possible local designations, and expedite environmental review by governmental agencies.

Information collected during a historic architecture survey includes, but is not limited to: an area's developmental history, individual building types and architectural styles, estimated dates of construction, historic and contemporary photographs, current building uses, and an initial determination of eligibility for the National Register of Historic Places. While basic, standard survey efforts do not gather all the kinds of information needed for local preservation planning, environmental review, National Register nominations, or historical research, it does serve as a foundation for those preservation activities.<sup>1</sup>

## **Executive Summary**

The FindIt Program performs surveys that identify extant physical historic resources in a specific area, providing the basis for local designation, neighborhood revitalization, and other preservation activities. FindIt is housed at the Center for Community Design & Preservation (CCDP) at the University of Georgia (UGA) College of Environment and Design (CED). The program is a unique student learning experience whereby graduate students in historic preservation, landscape architecture, and urban planning are trained to identify and document a breadth of cultural resources, such as historic buildings, landscapes, and other structures.

FindIt is sponsored by the Georgia Transmission Corporation in partnership with the Georgia Department of Natural Resources-Historic Preservation Division, the Georgia Department of Transportation, and the UGA Carl Vinson Institute of Government's Information Technology Outreach Services.

The Newtown survey was commissioned by Historic Athens and the Athens-Clarke County Planning Department to more fully understand the history of this older neighborhood. FindIt students surveyed the Newtown neighborhood during the Fall 2019 and Spring 2020 semesters. FindIt documented all buildings over 40 years old, completing a Georgia Historic Resources survey form for each property. The survey area was situated within the western border of Barber Street, the eastern border of the railroad, the northern border of the Bobby Snipes Water Resources Center, and the southern border of the railroad as it intersects with Pulaski Street. For the purposes of this survey, the historic resources were predominantly evaluated for their architectural integrity.

The information collected by the field survey was entered into Georgia's Natural, Archaeological, Historic Resources Geographic Information Systems (GNAHRGIS) database under survey ID 2395, "FindIt Clarke County," and can be accessed at: https://www.gnahrgis.org/.

The city of Athens, Georgia, was established in 1785 as the location of a university. Situated along the North Oconee River, Athens also grew to be a center for the textile industry, as cotton was readily available from the neighboring plantations. The city grew along with industry, as several mills and manufacturing companies developed along the river. Athens was also an economic center for Black people in the region, having the largest concentration of Black businesses, including lawyers, doctors, and dentists, as well as merchants and entertainment venues.

Several industries surrounded the Newtown neighborhood in the late nineteenth and early twentieth centuries. In 1893, the Athens Water Works was built along the Oconee River to provide clean water for the city. Founded circa 1894, the R. L. Moss Manufacturing Company, makers of sashes, doors, and windows, was operating along the Southern Railroad line, and just west of the railroad tracks was the Gulf Refining Company. Standard Oil Company developed west of the railroad tracks along Standard Oil Road.

The name "Newtown" can be traced back to the late 1800s and is exhibited in Athens City Directories and Maps. The formation of the Newtown residential neighborhood began in the first two decades of the twentieth century, with the neighborhood well populated by 1926. It can be surmised that its location as a Black neighborhood grew from the

availability of undeveloped parcels on less desirable land between the river and industry, yet close to main transportation corridors. Map and City Directory research reveal that in Newtown's early years there existed two churches, a school, and a lodge, all listed as "colored" facilities. The 1926 Sanborn Fire Insurance Map of Athens notes the Newtown Grammar School located on Athens Avenue, Newtown Baptist Church, also referred to as Dorsey's Tabernacle, on Savannah Avenue, St. John's A.M.E. Church on Stephens Street, and Lodge Hall 2 also on Savannah Avenue. The 1920–1921 Athens City Directory lists the residents of the Newtown neighborhood by street and details which houses were occupied by Black individuals and families. Nearly all the houses on Athens, Atlanta, Augusta, and Cleveland Avenues were occupied by Black residents.

The Newtown neighborhood includes 5 parcels with public housing units all built in the 1960s. During this decade, Athens undertook several federally funded "urban renewal" projects aimed at removing "blighted" areas of the city. This movement was funded by the presidential administrations of Roosevelt, Truman, and Johnson. President Truman's administration passed the Federal Housing Act of 1949 which provided funds for public housing and for "slum clearance." The acquisition and demolition of their property by the city perpetuated the effects of discrimination and inequity felt by Athens' Black residents.

The Newtown neighborhood is now home to a broader demography of Athens residents of all races — including young couples with children, single people, and students of the University of Georgia. Though the neighborhood has evolved from its origins as a predominantly Black residential neighborhood, its architectural resources reflect its history, demonstrated through the numerous working–class homes and public housing sites.


FindIt documented a total of 152 historic buildings within the Newtown neighborhood, with the majority constructed between 1910 and 1929. These resources are predominately single-family residential structures, interspersed by a few public housing units..


The residential building types and architectural styles found in Newtown are typical of the early to mid-twentieth century resources that are commonly found in communities of the Southeastern United States. "Building type" refers to the overall form of the building as well as the general layout of the interior rooms. "Architectural Style" is the decoration or ornamentation that has been put on a house, and often reflects the needs and tastes of a particular time and a place.

The building types in Newtown are varied, but the two most represented building types are the Saddlebag and the Gabled Ell Cottage. Saddlebags represent 13.8% of the houses in Newtown and Gabled Ell Cottages 11.8%. Architectural styles found in Newtown include Craftsman and Folk Victorian. While the survey team identified many of the houses as having "No Academic Style", it should be noted that this means the building is historic but does not exhibit characteristics or elements of an "academic style" of architecture and is considered a vernacular representation.

Many buildings in Newtown exhibit some form of historic integrity issues. Many of the pre-World War II buildings have undergone significant alterations, including additions, porch removal or enclosure, synthetic siding, as well as window or door replacement. These alterations often affect the design, materials, or workmanship of the particular resource, which invariably negatively affect the historic feeling and significance. Furthermore, the alterations must be assessed when determining the authenticity or integrity of a historic structure during the National Register of Historic Places nomination process.

Despite these issues Newtown still has the ability to demonstrate its history through its historic resources and built environment. The Newtown neighborhood could be recognized as an important residential district, revealing a fuller history of Black Athenians and the community that lived there.





# **Project Description**

This survey was commissioned by Historic Athens and the Athens-Clarke County Planning Department to understand the history of this older neighborhood. Historic Athens approached Athens-Clarke County Unified Government with the idea to use their revolving fund to begin the process of neighborhood revitalization. At the same time, Athens-Clarke County was exploring options on how to determine which neighborhoods were eligible for preservation incentives and protection from developmental pressures that local historic district designation can provide. Since a historic architecture survey provides base data for a particular area, FindIt was commissioned for a Phase I Historic Architecture Survey of the Newtown neighborhood to inform Historic Athens' revitalization efforts and ACC's future local designations.

The survey area included all parcels between the western border of Barber Street, the eastern border of the railroad, the northern border of the Bobby Snipes Water Resources Center, and the southern border of the railroad as it intersects with Pulaski Street. The survey documented all buildings and sites 40 years of age or older (as of January 1, 2020) which were visible from the public right-of-way.

The work was performed by Master of Historic Preservation graduate students under the supervision of Center for Community Design & Preservation staff. The survey consisted of historical and developmental research of the project area, windshield and pedestrian field survey of architectural resources, as well as data collection and analysis. The survey data is summarized in this report in tabular form; descriptions and photographs for all resources can be found under the 'Resource Templates' section of this report.





# Methodology

The survey was conducted according to the procedures outlined in The Georgia Historic Resources Survey Manual. Prior to fieldwork, research was conducted using Athens-Clarke County Tax Assessor records.



The survey was conducted according to the procedures outlined in the Georgia Historic Resources Survey Manual and National Register Bulletin, *Guidelines for Local Surveys: A Basis for Preservation Planning.* The surveyors used a combination of USGS base maps and tax assessor parcel data to identify potentially historic parcels and structures. The area was surveyed over the course of several days with systematic coverage of the project

Per Georgia State Historic Preservation guidance, a Georgia Historic Resources survey form was completed for buildings 40 years of age, regardless of architectural integrity. Properties which did not meet the age requirement of 40 years were not surveyed. Each assigned resource within the subject area was assessed for architectural integrity. A structure with architectural integrity is one that generally retains its original location, design, setting, materials, workmanship, feeling, and association. The physical condition of the structures was not a consideration.

All properties surveyed were assigned identification numbers and documented with the completion of a Georgia Historic Resource Survey Form, as well as photo documentation and corresponding georeferencing data. The survey form includes information about the use, style, floor plan, materials, context, physical description, and an accurate determination of the date of construction and additions.



Sources utilized for age determination and architectural style type and description included Lee and Virginia McAlester's A Field Guide to American Houses, the Georgia Historic Resources Survey Manual, Georgia's Living Places, and A Visual Guide to Architecture by Francis D.K. Ching. All dates of construction are presented in approximations unless explicitly identified by markers or other documentation. Tax Assessor data was also referenced for date accuracy.

Upon completion of the fieldwork, all collected data was entered into the Georgia Natural Archaeological Historic Geographic Information System (GNAHRGIS), under survey ID 2395, "FindIt Clarke County." Newly identified resources were assigned a unique GNAHRGIS identification number.

Historical research was conducted with an emphasis on Sanborn maps, tax records, and archival material. Additionally, historic Athens maps, published resources and oral accounts were used to establish the developmental history of Newtown.

## All identified resources were approximately 40 years old or older.



The area was surveyed over the course of several days with a systematic coverage of the project area. Each resource within the assigned boundaries was assessed for age and architectural integrity.



Each resource was evaluated for potential listing in the National Register of Historic Places.

## Criteria for Evaluation

## **National Register for Historic Places**

Each resource was evaluated for eligibility to list in the National Register of Historic Places (NRHP). The criteria for listing are outlined in the National Register Bulletin How to Apply the National Register Criteria for **Evaluation** published by the U.S Department of Interior, National Park Service. Cultural resources can be defined as eligible for the NRHP if they:

- A. Are associated with events that have had a significant contribution to a broad pattern of history; or
- **B.** Are associated with the lives of persons significant in the past;
- C. Embody distinctive characteristics of a type, period, or method of construction, or represent the work of a master, possess high artistic values, or represent a significant and distinguished entity whose components may lack distinction; or
- D. Have yielded or may be likely to yield, information important to history or prehistory.<sup>2</sup>

Ordinarily cemeteries, birthplaces, or graves of historical figures, properties owned by religious institutions or used for religious purposes, structures that have been moved from their original locations, reconstructed historic buildings, properties primarily commemorative in nature, and properties that have achieved significance within the last 50 years are not considered eligible for the National Register. However, properties will qualify if they are integral parts of districts that do meet the criteria or they fall within the following categories:

- **a.** A religious property deriving primary significance from architectural or artistic distinction or historical importance; or
- b. A building or structure removed from its original

- location but which is significant primarily for architectural value, or which is the surviving structure most importantly associated with a historic person or event; or
- c. A birthplace or grave of a historical figure of outstanding importance if there is no appropriate site or building directly associated with his or her productive life; or
- **d.** A cemetery which derives its primary significance from graves or persons of transcendent importance, from age, from distinctive design features, or from association with historic events; or
- e. A reconstructed building when accurately executed in a suitable environment and presented in a dignified manner as part of a restoration master plan, and when no other building or structure with the same association has survived; or
- **f.** A property achieving significance within the last 50 years if it is of exceptional importance.

For a property to qualify for the National Register it must meet one of the National Register Criteria for Evaluation by:

- Being associated with an important historical context and
- Retaining historic integrity of those features to convey its significance.

To determine whether a property or site retains integrity, it needs to be evaluated for the aspects of its location, design, setting, workmanship, materials, feeling, and association to convey its historic significance.3

For the purposes of this survey, the historic resources were predominantly evaluated for their architectural integrity, and not their local or cultural significance.












Figure 2. 470 Atlanta Ave, 1967


# DEVELOPMENTAL HISTORY

### LOCATION

The city of Athens, Georgia, was established in 1785 as the location of a university. Situated along the North Oconee River, Athens also grew to be a center for the textile industry, as cotton was readily available from the neighboring farms. The city grew along with industry, as several mills and manufacturing companies developed along the river. Athens was also an economic center for Black peo in the region, having the largest concentration of Black businesses, including lawyers, doctors, and dentists, as well as merchants and entertainment venues.

The name "Newtown" can be traced back to the late 1800s and is exhibited in Athens City Directories and Maps. The neighborhood is located in the west quadrant of Athens, north of Downtown. It

is bound by Barber Street to the west, the Bobby Snipes Water Resource Center to the north, and the railroad to the east and south. It can be surmised that its location as Black neighborhood grew from the availability of undeveloped parcels on less desirable land between the river and industry, yet close to main transportation corridors.

### **INDUSTRY**

Several industries surrounded the Newtown neighborhood in the late nineteenth and early twentieth centuries. In 1893, the Athens Water Works was built along the Oconee River to provide clean water for the city. Founded circa 1894, the R. L. Moss Manufacturing Company, makers of sashes, doors, and windows, was operating along the Southern Railroad line, and just west of the railroad tracks was the

Gulf Refining Company. Standard Oil Company developed west of the railroad tracks along Standard Oil Road.

Described in the 1909 Athens City Directory in a section titled "Our Manufacturing Industries," the Moss Manufacturing Company was praised for its work, "The finest buildings in our city are examples of their skill, and up-to-date facilities equipped with the most modern machinery and with a capacity to furnish double the quantity of our city's requirements. They make a specialty of promptly filling your orders, and economic consideration in this day of hustle."

Newtown began to develop fully in the first two decades of the twentieth century, with the neighborhood well populated by 1926. Map and City Directory research reveal that in Newtown's early years there existed two churches, a school, and a lodge, all listed as "colored" facilities. The 1926 Sanborn Fire Insurance Map of Athens notes the Newtown Grammar School located on Athens Avenue, Newtown Baptist Church, also referred to as Dorsey's Tabernacle, on Savannah Avenue, St. John's A.M.E. Church on Stephens Street, and Lodge Hall 2 also on Savannah Avenue.

The Dorsey Tabernacle Baptist Church was established in 1889 and was relocated to 135 Mulberry Street in 1974. In 1909, Athens City Directory lists Rev. J.T. Dorsey as the pastor. The buildings of the two churches and the lodge are no longer extant, but the Newtown Grammar School building is currently used by Hurley Funeral Home. (Figure 4)

The Newtown neighborhood is still primarily residential but does include some commercial resources including Marmalade Pottery/

Southern Star Studio, and Athens Area Homeless Shelter. Gilree Upholstery, located on Pulaski Street, is a Black-owned business that has been a staple of the Newtown neighborhood for decades.

The 1967 revision of the 1926 Sanborn Fire Insurance Map reveals that Moss Manufacturing Company was replaced by Athens Labor Company, operating out of the same complex. Standard Oil Company, not in existence in 1926, was located at the corner of Barber Street and Atlanta Avenue. The Newtown Grammar School was occupied by an undertaker and two additions were added to the rear of the building. St. John's A.M.E. Church was no longer extant. The Dorsey's Tabernacle building was being used by a vendor. Additionally, public housing units were built on Macon, Athens, and Atlanta Avenues.

#### **RESIDENTS**

The 1920–1921 Athens City Directory lists the residents of the Newtown neighborhood by street and details which houses were occupied by Black individuals and families. Nearly all the houses on Athens, Atlanta, Augusta, and Cleveland Avenues were occupied by Black residents. Newtown resident occupations included firemen, drivers, janitors, carpenters, station attendendants, and other working–class occupations.

### **BLACK EDUCATION**

Following the Civil War and emancipation, Athens became a center for secondary Black education signaling the emergence of a significant Black middle class. In Athens there were several prominent schools for African Americans including The Knox School (later renamed the Knox Institute), the

Methodist School, and Jeruel Academy. The Knox Institute, which opened in 1868, was the first school for Black students in Athens. By 1913, Knox Institute covered twelve grades and offered music and domestic science classes in addition to the typical curriculum. The great success of this school lead to the establishment of other schools for Black children around Athens.

Athens historian, Michael L. Thurmond describes the development of Black schools in Athens and attributes the establishment of the Newtown Grammar School to overcrowding, "the little children could not be placed in school, and if they could have been, the schools were too crowded for them to have thorough instruction. The need for another negro grade school became evident and a four-room grade school was added in 1911–1912, the corps of teachers being increased to 17."2 Thurmond goes on to explain that the addition of the Newtown School did not solve the issue of overcrowding at the West Broad Street School. During the 1912–1913 school year,

there was a total first grade enrollment of 104 with an average daily attendance of 105.


This large number of students compelled one teacher to teach in split sessions, holding one section until 11:30 in the morning, then teaching a second until 2:00 in the afternoon. An early account of the Newtown Grammar School describes it as a "serviceable and rather comfortable fourroom building."<sup>3</sup>

#### DEVELOPMENT

Figure 5 shows the settlement patterns of African Americans in Athens, displaying the Newtown neighborhood combined with Pulaski Heights. The railroad tracks divide these two neighborhoods.

The first houses in Newtown were built along Cleveland Avenue, west of the railroad, as well as along Pulaski, Tibbetts, and Kendene Streets. The neighborhood expanded northward, populating Atlanta, Athens, Macon, Savannah (previously Atlantic) Avenues, and Stevens and Barber Streets.

#### **URBAN RENEWAL**

The Newtown neighborhood includes 5 parcels with public housing units all built in the 1960s. During this decade, Athens undertook several federally funded "urban renewal" projects aimed at removing "blighted" areas of the city.

This movement was funded by the presidential administrations of Roosevelt, Truman, and Johnson. President Truman's Administration passed the Federal Housing Act of 1949 which provided funds for public housing and for "slum clearance."

Two areas in Athens were target for "urban renewal" in the 1960s. One area was near the University of Georgia. It was sold to the University for the expansion of the campus, and once the residents were relocated and their homes were razed, the University built high-rise dormitories on the site. This effort, called Project 50, displaced 80 families.

The second area was much larger, located north of downtown Athens. This area included neighborhoods called "Lickskillet" and "The Bottoms." This project dislocated 233 families, the majority of whom were "non-white."

The acquisition and demolition of their property by the city perpetuated the effects of discrimination and inequity felt by Athens' Black residents.

The Newtown neighborhood is now home to a broader demography of Athens residents, as well as students of the University of Georgia. Though the neighborhood has evolved from its origins as a predominantly Black-occupied neighborhood, its architectural resources reflect its history, demonstrated through the numerous working-class homes and public housing sites.




Figure 7 - Map of the City of Athens, 1895




Figure 8 - Map of the City of Athens, 1944





Figure 11 - Newtown on 1925 Map of Athens





# **Survey Results**

A total of 152 resources were documented within the Newtown neighborhood in Athens, Georgia. Overwhelmingly, residential and commercial buildings are the dominant resource type with 147 (96.7%). Additionally, there are 2 commercial properties, 1 school, 1 barn, and 1 structure. The resources in Newtown are predominantly residential with 135 (88.8%) as single living units and 6 (3.9%) accommodating multiple living units.

The building types in Newtown are varied, but the two most represented building types are the Saddlebag (21) and the Gabled Ell Cottage (18). Saddlebags represent 13.8% of the houses in Newtown and Gabled Ell Cottages 11.8%.

A total of 123 (80.9%) resources exhibited 'no academic style.' A building with 'no academic style' does not exhibit any characteristic or elements of a high style of architecture. Buildings categorized as 'no academic style' may be vernacular representations built with little to no decorative elements that would reflect an architectural style. It is also possible that buildings categorized as 'no academic style' may have had an architectural style initially, but have lost these decorative and stylistic elements over time, often due to physical alterations and material changes. Elements of the Craftsman style were identified on 14 resources which is typically associated with 1910s and 1920s construction. Additionally, 10 resources exhibited Folk Victorian elements from turn of the century construction. 'Plain style' is a style unique to midcentury Ranch houses and was present on 3 of the Ranch houses in Newtown. The Ranch Houses demonstrate the post–World War II development in the neighborhood as part of a larger movement statewide. One resource, previously the Newtown Grammar School, features Colonial Revival Style.

The majority of construction in Newtown occurred between 1910 and 1929 (1910–1919: 30.9%, 1920–1929: 27.6%). Approximate dates of construction were determined using the date listed by the tax assessor, historic maps, and aerial images. Two resources were constructed between 1900–1909; eighteen resources were built between 1930 and 1939, and fourteen were built between 1960–1969.

# ARCHITECTURAL ANALYSIS


The integrity of the surveyed properties varies widely. Many of the inventoried resources exhibit some form of integrity issues. Resources with poor architectural integrity are unable to adequately express their historic significance. Many pre–World War II resources have undergone significant alterations to their footprint or exterior cladding, including the use of synthetic materials. Other alterations include but are not limited to: porch removal or enclosure, window or door replacement, etc. Many mid–century resources maintain a high level of integrity with minimal alterations. Routine maintenance such as roof repair or repointing were not considered when evaluating architectural integrity.

Of the resources with minimal alterations, twenty-six (17.1%) appear to meet the National Register Criteria for listing. Seventy-five (49.3%) resources 'may meet' the National Register criteria. These resources have fair to good architectural integrity, but warrant further research as to their historic significance.

Forty-two (27.6%) documented resources do not appear to meet the National Register eligibility standards. These resources may maintain historic significance but have undergone extensive alterations which hinder the resource's architectural integrity. These alterations often affect the design, materials, or workmanship of the particular resource, which invariably negatively affect the historic feeling and significance. Field determinations were not made for nine resources due to obstruction, deterioration, or extreme alteration and need more information to determine whether or not they meet the National Register eligibility standards.







# Building Types of Newtown

Building type refers to the overall form of the building, the outline or "envelope" of the main or original part of the house, as well as the general layout of the interior rooms. The house type can identify whether the house is a rare or common form, and in some cases, the historical period in which the house was built.

The simplest definition of house type is the formula: plan + height = type.

# **Bungalow: Hip**



Bungalow house forms are long and low with irregular floor plans within an overall rectangular shape. Integral porches are common, as are low-pitched roofs with wide overhangs. Bungalows were very popular in all regions of Georgia between 1900 and 1930, almost as popular in rural areas as in cities and towns.

# **Bungalow: Front Gable**



Front Gable Bungalows are a subtype of the over-all Bungalow plan. There are four subtypes: Side Gable, Hipped, Front Gable, and Cross Gable. All four subtypes are represented statewide. This subtype has a front-facing gable roof and often includes a front porch also roofed with a front-facing gable.

# **Bungalow: Side Gable**



Side Gable Bungalows are a subtype of the over-all Bungalow plan. This subtype has a side-oriented gable roof, but often includes a front porch with a front-facing gable or a roof dormer.

# **Central Hallway Cottage**



The Central Hallway Cottage was very popular in Georgia throughout the nineteenth century. They consist of a central hallway between two rooms, and they are only built one room deep. A gable roof is most common and often found with chimneys on one or both ends. Central Hallway Cottages can be found in rural and urban areas.

# **Commercial Block**



Commercial Block buildings may contain one or more individual commercial or office spaces; the primary identifiying characteristic is the two- or three- story height.

# **Double Pen Cottage**



Double-pen houses consist of two rooms, typically square. The arrangement of rooms varies, but the most notable characteristic of the double-pen are the two doors on the main facade. Gable roofs are the most common roof types. Double-pens were typically constructed for agricultural or industrial workers between the 1870s and the 1930s.

# **Duplex**



A duplex can take the form of a building that resembles a single family home with the interior divided to accommodate two separate living units, or an apartment-like structure with two living units. The defining characteristic of a duplex is two distinct and separate entrances from the exterior that indicate two living units.

# **Gabled Ell Cottage**



In plan, it is T- or L-shaped, and it usually, though not always, has a gabled roof. Sometimes called the gable- front-and-wing or the gabled ell house type, the gabled wing cottage consists of a gable-front at one end of a recessed wing that is parallel to the facade. The gabled ell cottage was popular in both rural and urban areas. Its period of greatest popularity was 1875–1915.

# **New South Cottage**



The New South cottage was a popular house type between the 1890s and the 1920s. It has a central square mass, usually with a hipped roof, and gabled projections; the key element of which is the central hallway plan. The central hallway is flanked by pairs of rooms, one or both of which might project forward. A pair of gables in the facade frequently provided additional symmetry to this house type.

# **Pyramid Cottage**



The Pyramid Cottage consists of a cubical mass capped by a pyramidal roof. There are four principal rooms and no hallway. The Pyramid Cottage was popular between 1910 and 1930. They are usually found in regions between the fall line and coasts in rural areas and on the outside of city centers.

# **Queen Anne Cottage**



The Queen Anne Cottage is characterized by a square main mass with projecting gables on the front and side. The rooms are arranged asymmetrically, and there is no central hallway. Although not as ubiquitous as the gabled wing cottage, the Queen Anne cottage does appear in both urban and rural areas as popular middle-class housing of the 1880s and 1890s.

## Ranch



The ranch house has a long, narrow, rectangular shape, with or without projections. Bedrooms are clustered at one end, the principal entry and living spaces near the center and the garage or carport at the other end. The roof is typically very lowpitched. Bedrooms are grouped in one end and the entry and living spaces in the other. Ranch Houses were built primarily between 1945–1980.

# Saddlebag



The Saddlebag is named due to the central chimney flanked by two rooms that seem to hang suspended on either side of the chimney. Saddlebag houses may have two doors entering into each room or a central door opening into a small vestibule. In rural areas, they were built between 1830 and 1840. Later, they were popular on the fringes of towns and cities, and from 1910 to 1930 as mill village construction.

## School



An educational structure, schools vary widely in plan and style. The school building type in the Newtown neighborhood is a one-story structure with brick siding and a linear composition.

# Shotgun



Shotgun houses are predominately found in urban areas built for mainly low-income workers between the 1870s and 1920s. They are one room wide and two or more rooms deep. Shotgun houses do not have a hallway, and all the doors usually line up front to back. While gabled roofs are most common, they can also have hipped roofs.

# **Side Gable Cottage**




The Side Gable Cottage has a square mass consisting of four rooms and no hallway. They almost always have a gable roof. The Side Gable Cottage was an economical house type with two variants. They could either have four equal rooms or a hall–parlor plan where two of the rooms are larger than the two next to them. Side Gable Cottages were most popular as workers houses between 1895 and 1930.

# **Unidentified House Type**



Unidentified house types cannot be categorized into existing house typologies. These structures may be heavily altered, or are house types that do not have a defined period of significance existing historic context in which to evaluate them.





# Architectural Styles of Newtown

The architecture of a house, its overall form and ornamentation, is classified as a style. Style is the decoration or ornamentation that has been put on a house in a systematic pattern or arrangement. Style has long been an important tool for describing, analyzing, and evaluating historic buildings; a style often reflects the needs and tastes of a particular time and a place in which it appears. Styles used during a particular time and in a particular location may contribute to an understanding of the culture of that period.

# Colonial Revival (1890-1955)



Most Colonial Revival buildings are symmetrical. A central entranceway is elaborated with a pediment supported by pilasters or columns. The use of broken pediments, fanlights and sidelights is common. Classical cornices with dentils or modillions are usually present. The roof may be hipped or side-gabled with dormers. Windows have double-hung sashes, usually with six-over-six or nine-over-nine panes. Walls are of masonry, masonry-veneer or wood.

# **Folk Victorian (1870-1920)**



Folk Victorian houses were built across Georgia as simple house forms with Victorian-era decorative detailing such as jigsaw woodworks including brackets, spindlework and gingerbread trim. Popular during the mid to late 19th century, features were borrowed from elaborate styles like Queen Anne or Italianate added onto places like porches and roof gables.

# Craftsman (1910-1930)



The Craftsman house has a low-pitched roof giving a generally horizontal effect. The widely over-hanging eaves are open with exposed rafters. Large gables have decorative brackets or braces at the eaves and roof dormers are common. Porches have short square columns set on heavy masonry piers extending to the ground. Craftsman houses are most often asymmetrical with a generally open and functional plan.

# No Academic Style



A property evaluated as 'No Academic Style,' contains no elements of High Style architecture, and is considered a vernacular representation. Residential and commercial structures may have elements of 'High Style' architecture but not enough to be considered a 'High Style' example.

# **Plain (Ranch House) (1945-1980)**




This is the signature Ranch House style for Georgia. It is typically represented by the red brick Ranch House that visually emphasizes the fundamentals of form, roofline, and window openings.

# **Unknown (Insufficient Information)**



Buildings with 'unknown' architectural style may be representational architecture or architecture parlant which have elements or features that allude to classical styles, but which do not prescribe to any particular 'high' or vernacular style. An 'unknown' may also be obscured by vegetation or construction materials and require further investigation.





# Conclusion

The Newtown neighborhood was originally predominantly occupied by Athens' Black working-class residents which its architectural resources reflect. The neighborhood was started in the late 19th century with most of its early construction taking place in the period between 1910 and 1929. Many remaining houses are typical of that period including saddlebags and gabled ell cottages. Saddlebags were common house types for industrial and agricultural workers, revealing that many Newtown residents were likely working class. One resource unique to Newtown is the Newtown Grammar School, now Hurley Funeral Home, which taught Black children in the neighborhood.

The construction of several public housing duplexes in the 1960s speaks to the forced implementation of Urban Renewal policies, as well as the perceived economic status, condition, and value of the neighborhood at that time. However, Newtown has continued to evolve, as current residents come from various economic backgrounds. Newtown is close to the University of Georgia and is now popular among students as well as Athens professionals.

While many of the historic buildings have had extensive alterations over the years leading to integrity issues, Newtown still has the ability to demonstrate its history through its historic resources and built environment. The developmental history of the Newtown neighborhood that is included in this report is only a sliver of what could be recovered. The Newtown neighborhood is worthy of more robust research to address the cultural and social history of Black Athenians, particularly the community that built this neighborhood. Digging deeper into this history is a valuable and necessary pursuit in order to inspire increased education, advocacy, and protection.
