<u>Employment Status:</u> 92% of the students who graduated during 2024 (and who are not pursuing graduate studies) have secured positions in landscape architecture or a related field. (approximately 8% unknown)

<u>Academic Performance:</u> The MLA students carry an average course unit load per semester of 14 to 16 hours.

Fall 2024 entering MLA students have an average graduate GPA of 3.60 after their first year.

Fall 2023 entering MLA students have an undergraduate mean GPA of 3.44. The GRE is not required for admission to the MLA program.
