

SPEAKER AGREEMENT

Landscape Architecture Short Course

This Speaker Agreement (“Agreement”) is entered into by and between the Board of Regents of the University System of Georgia by and on behalf of the University of Georgia (“UGA”) and (“Speaker”). UGA enters this Agreement on behalf of the UGA College of Environment and Design and the University of Georgia Center for Continuing Education. UGA and Speaker are each a “Party” and collectively the “Parties.”

1. Engagement of Speaker.

A. Speaker shall deliver a professional presentation at the Jackson Street Building in Athens, GA.

2. Speaker Responsibilities

- A. **Speaker Information Form.** Speaker shall submit a completed speaker information form by the relevant deadline.
- B. **Vendor Registration.** Speaker shall complete UGA’s non-employee payment form and obtain a vendor ID if not already registered.
- C. **Copyright Compliance.** Speaker shall credit all third-party sources and shall provide proof of permissions for any material exceeding Fair Use limits. Speaker is responsible for compliance with all federal and state copyright laws, including Title 17 of the U.S. Code.

4. **Intellectual Property.**

- A. **Ownership of Underlying Content.** Speaker retains ownership of Speaker's original presentation content, including text, graphics, presentation slides, and other intellectual property created for the presentation ("Presentation Content").
- B. **License to UGA.** Speaker grants to UGA a perpetual, irrevocable, worldwide, royalty-free, transferable, sublicensable, non-exclusive license to use, reproduce, distribute, publicly display, publicly perform, archive, and create derivative works of the Presentation Content, and to use Speaker's name, likeness, and biography in connection with the Event and UGA's use of the Presentation Content.
- C. **Assignment of Recording.** Speaker assigns to UGA all rights, title, and interest in and to the video and audio recording(s) of the presentation ("Recording"), as further described in **Exhibit A**. UGA shall own the Recording exclusively and may edit, adapt, excerpt, distribute, publicly display, publicly perform, archive, or monetize the Recording in any media format.

5. **Warranties and Indemnity.**

Speaker represents and warrants that (a) Speaker owns or has secured all necessary rights to the Presentation Content; (b) the Presentation Content does not infringe any third-party rights; and (c) Speaker's performance of this Agreement complies with all applicable laws. Speaker agrees to indemnify and hold UGA harmless from and against any loss, damage, costs, liability and expenses (including reasonable attorneys' fees) for the infringement of any patent, copyright or trademark rights or other intellectual property rights of third parties which result from UGA's use of the Presentation Content.

6. **Independent Contractor.**

Speaker is an independent contractor and not an employee, agent, or representative of UGA. Speaker is responsible for all taxes arising from the honorarium.

7. **Miscellaneous.**

- A. **Governing Law.** This Agreement is governed by the laws of the State of Georgia.
- B. **Entire Agreement.** This Agreement, including Exhibit A, constitutes the entire agreement between the Parties.
- C. **Amendment.** Amendments must be in writing and signed by both Parties.
- D. **Execution.** This Agreement may be executed electronically and in counterparts.
